ASSOCIATE MEMBERS - may -

- 1. Attend and vote at any Annual or General Meeting of the Club.
- 2. Play in Club events, as long as an Official Handicap has been gained, but excluding Club Championships or other Club trophy events.
- Only play two Saturday/Thursday competitions throughout the whole year, after which they must become full members and pay full subscriptions.

CHAMPIONSHIPS

Championship will be run on stroke play, with grades set from the day before the first round. Qualifying rounds will be played on the dates set out in the programme. To qualify players must hand in three cards from the four rounds. All men's stroke championship rounds commence at 12 noon. A disc draw will be made on the morning of each championship round to determine starting order in each grade. Any player can play in all four rounds, but only the best three will count. Junior A and Junior B grades will play their first final 18 hole round on Saturday 30th September and their final 18 hole round on Saturday 7th October. Both these rounds will count for their final score to find the champions in their grades.

There will be two reserve days. The first one the week after round two (if needed) And the second one the week after round 4 (if needed).

Senior and Intermediate grades will hold their 36 hole final day on October 2nd starting at 8am to find the champion in each of their grades.

Nett prizes will be given in each grade over the final 36 holes with the best men's nett winning the Gill Croy Cup.

A player is eligible to win both a Championship and a nett in his grade.

The aggregate of the three nett cards from the qualifying rounds in each grade decide the Allan Wright Trophies.

In the event of a tie for a championship, starting on No. 1, a further three holes will be played, and if still square, from No. 4 hole, a 'sudden death' play-off. Minor placings will be decided by a 'sudden death' play-off starting on No. 1 Tee.

DRUMMOND CUP (Captains Trophy)

This competition is to be played match play using handicaps. Members must have an official handicap to enter. Members must enter their names on the notice board by dates as laid out in programme. The first round must be played by dates as laid out in programme. No. 1 and No. 10 tees are to be used. If the game is all square at the eighteenth, sudden death play off taking strokes as they fall on the card starting on No. 1 or No. 10 original starting hole.

The format will now include a preliminary round where there are no byes.

If there is an odd number of players, the first person drawn out will go straight through to the main draw.

When the preliminary round is completed as per the

programme, there will be a main draw and plate draw. With required completion dates as per the programme.

Plate Round - First round losers will form a plate round competition.

MIXED PAIRS

Combined Stableford - (Match Play). Entries close 26th March.

MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

Three qualifying rounds stroke commencing Feb 19th, 8 players in each grade to qualify. Best two count. Match play off the stick, own grades.

THE A.W. GILLESPIE CHALLENGE TROPHY

For Stableford Competition

During the season Stableford competitions are set down on the official programme. The late Mr A.W. Gillespie has donated a Challenge Trophy to the club member gaining most points from the five (5) best rounds played during those official Stableford competitions.

TOWNSHEND TROPHY & BEXLEY TROPHY

The late Mr and Mrs R.C. Townshend have presented a Trophy for annual competition for a husband and wife combined - Mixed Stableford. This year it takes place on Saturday 12th August. Mr Ron Skurr has presented the Bexley Trophy for Drawn Mixed Pairs or Own Partners held on the same day as the Townshend Trophy using the competition.

Draw and Starting Time:

Official start time is 9.45am for 18-hole members; 11.30am for 9-hole members. Any player whose disc is not in by 9.30am (18-holers) 11.15am (9-holers), plays at the back of the field under starters instructions. The Draw is completed by the starters of the day using guidelines in the weekly competition book. The 9-Hole Programme will be the same as the 18-Hole Programme. 9-Hole players play alternate front/back course each week.

Entry Fee: For Thursday Competitions. 18-Hole \$5.00. Includes Ball Sweep, Machinery Levy, 2's and Nett Eagles. 9-Hole \$4.50 includes Ball Sweep, Machinery Levy, and 2's or Nett Eagle *(on alternate weeks)*.

Nominated Play Day: Thursday is our regular playing day however if unable to play on Thursdays you may nominate Saturday as your regular playing day for the season. Competition is as stipulated in the Programme and played on the Saturday **PRIOR** to the Thursday. If postponed on a Saturday, that competition to be played on the following Saturday. Cancellation or postponement to be at the discretion of Match Committee.

If circumstances change during the season you may apply to the Match Committee to have your nominated playing day changed for the remainder of the season. **Playing Matches on Club Days:** This is allowable under conditions set by the Match Committee, **except on championship qualifying days.** Cards will be acceptable for the competition of the day.

Extensions and Disputes: At any time, any player may apply to the Match Committee regarding competition disputes, extensions of time for competitions or dispensation to make changes to playing conditions of competitions. Applications must be received by the Match Committee, prior to the deadline date. The Match Committee decision will be final.

Committee Meetings: These are held on the first Thursday of the month or as notified by the Club Captain.

Saturday Golf: Women are welcome to play on Saturdays in mixed competition. Tee off at 12.00pm under starters direction.

Midweek Golf: Mixed golf is played on Tuesdays, tee off at 12.00pm. All members and visitors welcome.

Associate Members: Conditions as stated earlier in Club Programme.

Mixed Competitions: As described earlier in Club Programme.

COMPETITIONS AND TROPHIES

Championship Stroke Play: This will consist of 72 holes "off the stick" played in three grades as determined by the Match Committee. Players with NZ Golf approved handicaps (40.4 and below) will be eligible to play in Championships. Three qualifying rounds to be played on Thursdays as stated in the Programme with additional days scheduled, for any postponement. The players best two scores will be counted for qualifying with up to 8 players in each grade to play a further 36 holes on finals day or days as determined by the committee. These four cards will count as the 72-hole total. 9 Hole Championship will consist of 3 qualifying rounds, best two scores will be counted for qualifying with a further two 9-hole rounds to be played on the last Thursday and finals day.

In the event of a tie for Champion or Runner-up a sudden-death playoff will be played. A best nett prize will be given in each grade, to the player who has the best nett on finals day. **Captains Trophy:** These competitions are played as match play using handicaps. In the event of all square after the 18th, sudden death with strokes as they fall. Matches to start on No 1 hole.

Westacre Cup: Same conditions as Captains Trophy.

9-Hole Captains Trophy: Same conditions as Captains Trophy.

Jenny Esson Trophy: Best stableford over the field on designated competition day.

Drawn Canadian Foursomes, William Inch Trophy: Entries taken by date specified, players drawn randomly and draw completed by Match Committee. Match play, 50% of combined handicap.

LGU Medals: NZGA competition awarded to the best aggregate score of the best 4 rounds in LGU - 18-Hole played in three grades: 0-18.4, 18.5-26.8, 26.9-40.4; and 9 hole.

Match Play Championship: Three qualifying rounds of stroke play, best two count. 4 players in each grade playing match play off the stick as programmed.

9-Hole Match Play Champion played under the same conditions.

Oxford Rosebowl: Best three of four Stableford rounds during the season. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided on a count back of the best counting round.

9-Hole Stableford competition played under the same conditions.

NZGA Home links Competitions: handicaps 0-40.4 HI: Nancy McCormick Foursomes: foursomes over 36 holes. Coronation Medal (silver only), Aotearoa Cup (silver and bronze), Veterans Trophy (age 70 and over).

Ringers Competition: Best gross score on every hole, as scored on a week-to-week basis. This is transferred to a master card and scores are altered as a better score for the hole is achieved. Played over the season from 1st to last official golf Thursday in 3 grades 0 - 18.4, 18.5-26.8, 26.9-54 and 9-Hole.

Margaret Ford Trophy: Awarded to the best gross score in qualifying rounds.

Mildred Wolff Memorial Trophy: Best Nett over all grades on the 36 holes of Finals Day(s).

STARTERS DUTIES:

Starters to be at golf by 9.00am and bring a bottle of milk.

If you are unable to complete your duty, please arrange own substitute and notify Club Captain or Secretary.

Before Golf:

- Unlock all doors, fill and turn on zip and jug.
- Head up results book, put Ringers box and Disc Box out and take competition money listing names.
- Prepare closest to the pin and longest putt markers.
- Discs must be in by 9.30am. Late comers play at the back of the field under starters instructions.
- Complete draw according to competition.
- Turn off lights and heaters before going out to play.

After Golf:

- Calculate the number of prizes to be allocated. (Entry money divided by 4 = total prizes) (2s not included in prize total).
- Check cards and identify winners according to competition.
- Ensure results book is completed. List winners including 2s, closest to the pins and longest putt competitions.
- Replace starting discs.
- Tidy kitchen and extra dishes, remove dishwasher drain and turn off, wipe tables and replace chairs. Collect tea-towels and hand towels for washing, return on next golf day.
- Ensure toilet doors and windows are locked, turn off heaters and lights.

Cellphones to be turned off or to silent while playing.
